Camp Dress Code

Hope Reins in Texas desires an environment that is honoring to God. For this reason, the following items below are requirements for dress for all Hope Reins Camps.

- Closed-toed shoes and pants are required for any participation in horse activities of any kind.
- No undergarments are to be seen at any time.
- All shirts should have appropriate coverage of the back, shoulder, and ribcage areas (i.e. no open sides, open backs, spaghetti straps, or sleeveless tops).
- No clothing with suggestive, illegal, or otherwise inappropriate pictures or wording.
- No excessively tight clothing. No leggings or yoga pants are allowed.
- When participating in any water activities, a shirt and swim shorts are required. For our girls camps, shirts and swim shorts will be required to be worn over the bathing suit. Please ensure that the bathing suit will not be seen through the wet shirt or shorts.

If you think an outfit or specific clothing item is questionable, then we ask that you respectfully choose another item to wear. Hope Reins in Texas reserves the right to refuse an item of clothing in accordance with our Christian standards, our desire for professionalism, and our attempts for the highest level of safety possible.

Ranch Rules

- No alcohol, smoking or tobacco use of any kind allowed on the premises.
- No putting hands through stall railings, or railings around porches.
- No persons in horse pens or horse stalls without staff supervision and permission.
- No feeding animals without staff supervision and permission.
- No persons allowed on loading dock or in the arena without staff supervision and permission.
- Always listen and be respectful to camp staff and fellow campers.
- Speak softly, no screaming.
- No running on premises or jumping off steps or porches.
- No climbing on railings, gates, or fences.
- Be gentle and kind with others and horses.
- Only approach horses from the front and with camp staff present.
- **Day Camps:** Campers are NOT allowed to bring any electronic devices onto Hope Reins premises, except for medically required equipment. Any electronic device that is unapproved and used while at camp will be turned into the office, and returned at the end of the camp day.

Overnight Camps: Campers are NOT allowed to bring any electronic devices onto Hope Reins premises, except for medically required equipment and their personal cell phone. Personal cell phones will be collected at the beginning of camp and kept in the Hope Reins office for the duration of the camp. Hope Reins staff will give a specific time each day for campers to call home if they so desire. Any electronic device that is unapproved and used while at camp will be turned into the office, and returned at the end of the camp.
